INDIANAPOLIS – The Columbus Indiana Children's Choir (CICC) will be hosting the **Hoosier Hills Choral Festival** on **Saturday, October 29 at 3:30 pm** at the **First Christian Church** in Columbus. This choral festival celebrates the gathering of children's choirs from Indiana and surrounding states to bring children together through music.

This festival features the Columbus Indiana Children's Choir, along with the Cincinnati Children's Choir, Evansville Children's Choir, and Clifty Creek Elementary School Choir. This public performance does not require tickets for entry, but donations will be accepted during the free-will offering.

The CICC serves the children of the Columbus area through several choral programs. For grades three to eight, there are the auditioned choir groups Concert Choir and Descant Choir. There is also a Preparatory Program for grades one to three, and Early Childhood Program for ages four to five.
