## Enjoy Over Six Hours of Singing at the Indianapolis Children's Choir's Sing-A-Thon

INDIANAPOLIS - - The Indianapolis Children's Choir (ICC) will host its annual [Sing-A-Thon fundraising event on Saturday, November 5 from Noon to 6:30 pm](#). Singers from first grade through high school and beyond will perform a free concert at Shelton Auditorium on the Butler University Campus as the ICC raises funds towards its **\$40,000 fundraising goal**.

Sing-A-Thon is a celebration of the power of music that the ICC shares with the community as current ICC singers, families, alumni, supporters, friends, and corporate partners come together to support the ICC's mission. This impactful fundraising event helps to support ICC programming, scholarships, and outreach efforts that take place throughout the year. It's the single largest peer-to-peer fundraising event hosted by the choir, and the funds raised ensure that the ICC can continue to provide excellent choir programs for singers, as well as scholarships to families who need it, along with community outreach programs across central Indiana.

"This event is so important for the ICC," explains Joshua Pedde, Artistic Director. "Along with choirs performing for over 6 hours, the peer-to-peer fundraising piece is one of the largest ways we can continue to provide the excellent music programming that we offer to children. It especially ensures that we can serve the community through our outreach programs like the Neighborhood Choir Academy, Preschool Outreach Program, and Young Exceptional Singers Day."

The community is invited to support the ICC by donating to help the choir reach its \$40,000 fundraising goal and attend the free Sing-A-Thon performances on Saturday, November 5. It's an excellent opportunity to see the ICC's impact in action, as singers from nearly 25 different choirs and programs perform some of their favorite songs! Special choir guests include a group of ICC alumni singers, singers from the Crestwood Village North Senior Choir, and a selection of soloists from ICC choirs.
