## Choir to Host Singing Workshop for Indy Community with Artist in Residence

INDIANAPOLIS - - The Indianapolis Children's Choir (ICC) is proud to bring back its Neighborhood Choir Academy program on February 22 with a special one-day event that is open to children in the community. The workshop will feature ICC choral directors and current choir members, plus special guest clinician Dr. Anthony Trecek-King, who is a well-respected expert in the field of choral music.

"This program is specifically designed with our neighbors in mind," explains Amy Hughley, Associate Artistic Director of the ICC. "For this one-day version, the cost is low, the musical fun is at an all-time high, and it's overall a great way for children to get access to the ICC and what it is that we do."

Children in grades 4-8 are invited to attend the event where they can expect to learn vocal warmups, songs, and musical games. The day ends with a performance for families and friends so they can see all that the singers have learned. Participants are then invited to perform on the big stage with the ICC at the choir's concert on May 3, an opportunity typically reserved only for current full-time choir members.

"We are thrilled to have Dr. Trecek-King come to the ICC again as an Artist in Residence. He will be our guest clinician for this Neighborhood Choir Academy and will also be working directly with our advanced choirs on ear training techniques, vocal production, and a piece he arranged himself, in which the choir has an opportunity to compose themselves by improvising," shared Hughley.

Dr. Trecek-King is a leader in the choral music world with over 20 years of experience as a highly acclaimed choral conductor, scholar, pedagogue, and media personality. He is known for his collaborative rehearsal style which he will share with singers at the ICC through the event and at rehearsals.
