Indianapolis Children's Choir Hosts a Marathon of Music at Annual Sing-A-Thon

INDIANAPOLIS - - The Indianapolis Children's Choir (ICC) is hosting its annual [Sing-A-Thon](#) on Saturday, March 22. This event is a marathon of song that features ICC choir members and alumni singing for over six hours! The goal of the event is to help fund the choir's mission to bring meaningful music education to the central Indiana community. After a record-breaking year in 2024, the fundraising aim of this year's event has been heightened to \$50,000 and new special guests have been added to the entertainment lineup.

"We are kicking things off this year with an incredible \$10,000 matching gift from a generous donor, and that is really getting people excited," shares Associate Artistic Director of the ICC, Amy Hughley. "Thousands of young singers have been positively impacted by their ICC experience, and the funds we raise through this event will help us continue to provide that through our choirs and outreach programming."

The public is invited to share in the fun by attending Sing-A-Thon either in-person or virtually on [YouTube](#) to enjoy singing from the ICC's many choirs, including virtual performances from the Columbus Indiana Children's Choir and the Anderson Area Children's Choir and Youth Chorale. Even ICC alumni will come together to perform live and show their support. Throughout the event there will be solo and small ensemble performances as well, including an appearance from Erin Twenty Benedict, an ICC alum-turned college professor and professional recording artist.

"We are so lucky to have such an amazing community that comes together for this day of singing. For the younger kids and the public to see an ICC alum who is now a professional musician is very special, and it says a lot about the ICC," explains Hughley.

In addition to the many performances, Sing-A-Thon will feature ICC logo wear sales, a photo booth, and more that will all support the fundraising goal. ICC singers and families are already competing to raise funds and earn prizes, all while unlocking fundraising milestone levels for special events and giveaways.
