Indianapolis Children's Choir to Launch 39th Concert Season

INDIANAPOLIS - - This September the Indianapolis Children's Choir (ICC) will kick off its 39th Concert Season with two movie-themed events that are open to the Indianapolis community—an open house at the ICC Performing Arts Center on September 20 and the season debut concert, *Lights .Camera. Song.* on September 29.

"The theme of the movies is always a fun way to engage audiences since so many people have shared memories of great music from their favorite films," shares Joshua Pedde, Executive Artistic Director of the ICC. "At the concert we will pay homage to some classics and also perform some of the newer hits from recent films. It will be a great celebration of the progress of both the movie industry and the role that music has played in it."

About a week prior to the season-opening concert, the ICC will open the doors of its Performing Arts Center at 9111 Allisonville Road for a public open house on Friday, September 20. Families are invited to check out the facility, audition to join a choir, check out movie screenings, and enjoy free popcorn. The choir will also be screening the *Trio of Minuet* children's opera that the ICC debuted 20 years ago on WFYI. Costumes and memorabilia will be on display to commemorate the anniversary of the undertaking.

The *Lights .Camera. Song.* concert on Sunday, September 29 will be held at 6:00 pm at the STAR Bank Performing Arts Center in Zionsville. Singers in elementary through high school from across the state will share songs featured in classics from the big and silver screens. Enjoy songs from favorites like *The Wizard of Oz*, Disney classics, and much more in this exciting concert that celebrates the progress of sound.

"We are so excited to begin this season as we look towards our 40th anniversary next year. The idea is to begin this season in the past, and progress through old to new as we look ahead to what's to come for the ICC and our city," says Pedde.
