Indianapolis Children's Choir Kicks Off 40th Anniversary with Pay-What-You-Can Programming

INDIANAPOLIS - - As the Indianapolis Children's Choir (ICC) enters its 40th year, the organization will try a new and meaningful approach to opening its doors to the community with a [Day of Song](#) event on Saturday, August 16. This accessible, music-packed day is open to children who want to sing and the public in general, with music classes for kids and public performances and open house tours. All music classes are pay-what-you-can pricing and the performances and tours are all free.

"This is taking our [refreshed mission and vision statements](#) to the next level," explains Joshua Pedde, Executive Artistic Director of the ICC. "Since our founding in 1986, the ICC has always aimed to bring choral music to all children in the central Indiana community. This Day of Song is a very concrete way to do that for our area by removing the cost barrier."

Music programming for children in preschool-8th grade will run at various times from 9:00 am – 4:00 pm and require [registration](#). Free public performances will be held at 11:30 am and 4:00 pm, no ticket required. The performances will feature children who are participating in the classes that day, a true testament to the ability of the singers and the ICC's directors! The ICC Performing Arts Center will be open for public tours during the 9:00 am- 4:00 pm time frame as well, so the public can see the choir's headquarters and learn more about what programs are on offer. Open auditions for new singers in 4th grade and up will also be available all day, should children want to formally join an ICC weekly choir.

"This is just generally going to be a great time to see what the ICC is all about. Children will be able to experience the choral excellence of the ICC and the public can come visit us as we prepare for many celebrations during our big anniversary season," says Pedde.

The ICC plans to host subsequent Day of Song events during the 25-26 Concert Season with low-cost options for families, guest clinicians, and more. See the full schedule and registration details at icchoir.org/day-of-song
