## Indianapolis Children's Choir Opens 40<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Concert Season with Travel-Themed Concert, *Voyages*

INDIANAPOLIS - - The Indianapolis Children's Choir (ICC) is poised and ready to begin their 40<sup>th</sup> annual Concert Season this fall with the season opener *Voyages* on September 28, 2025. The travel-themed concert will be held at the STAR Bank Performing Arts Center and begin with a party – an actual birthday party to celebrate the ICC's big 4-0! Concert-goers will be treated to photo ops, logo wear sales, giveaways, and treats in the lobby area prior to the start of the performance.

"We are just so excited to usher in this magical and historic concert season," shares Joshua Pedde, Executive Artistic Director of the choir. "This concert will dive into one of the things that makes the ICC so special for our singers, which is the ability to tour the world to perform. A fact I always love to share is that the ICC has toured to every continent, except for Antarctica."

The audience can expect quite a global line-up of songs that reflect the influence from ICC's various trips and tours. Some highlights include pieces from the choir's travels to Hawaii for the Pacific Rim Children's Chorus Festival, the classic song "Homeland" from trips to the International Children's Choir Festival in Canterbury, England, and "Ubi Caritas" that was performed at St. Peter's Basilica in Vatican City. There will also be special guest performers to compliment the music from around the world. All of this will come together for a thrilling performance that will celebrate unity, harmony, and the universal power of music.

Pedde assures that this concert is just the beginning of a meaningful season of song, "All season long we will honor past directors and pay homage to some of the favorite songs from past ICC performances. Each of our concerts this year will take a look at an aspect of the ICC's past as we look ahead to the future of this organization that means so much to so many."

"Now is definitely the time to join us as we start our season," shares Pedde. "Singers in our kindergarten through high school choirs will be invited to join us for the culmination of this season, which is a trip to perform all together at Carnegie Hall in NYC!"
