## **Two Organizations Come Together for Free Holiday Concert in Anderson**

ANDERSON, IN - - The Anderson Area Children's Choir (AACC) will take the stage alongside the Fall Creek Valley Community Band (FCVCB) this November for a musical collaboration for the community. The concert will feature singers in the intermediate and high school choirs from the AACC, and the volunteer amateur musicians of the FCVCB, as they fill the Anderson First United Methodist Church sanctuary with music on Saturday, November 22 starting at 7:00 pm.

"This has become a great annual tradition for both organizations," shares Amy Hughley, Associate Artistic Director of the Indianapolis Children's Choir, and Director of the AACC high school ensemble. "It is a wonderful way for these talented singers and musicians to give the gift of free music to the Madison County community as the holiday season begins."

Both musically minded ensembles have been operating for many years in the Madison County area as outlets for musicians who want to practice and present their craft to the community. The AACC was founded in 1992 and offers programs and choirs for children ages 18 months-18 years old who wish to explore and develop choral music excellence. The choirs enroll new singers on a rolling basis. Based in Pendleton, The Fall Creek Valley Community Band has evolved over the years but has always been comprised of volunteer amateur musicians of varying backgrounds and occupations from around central Indiana.

Each group will perform their own musical selections and then come together as well to present select holiday repertoire. No ticket is required, and the public is encouraged to attend and arrive early to secure a seat.
